



MPT's Education Division launches new learning resources

While students were out of school and teachers were enjoying a well-deserved break, **MPT's Education Division** was busy creating innovative new resources for classrooms. The team produced and launched two educational media resources and a series of online courses for child care providers in Maryland.

The team developed a collection of 61 online inquiry kits to enhance students' research skills and make the process fun and engaging. Educators in the classroom can use these tools to teach students about everything from life in the early American colonies to challenges faced by a young nation after the Revolutionary War.

The division also finished an online professional development module for Allegany County Public School teachers, one that

is readily accessible to teachers nationwide. The module helps educators move from a teacher-focused method of instruction to a student-centered collaborative model.

MPT gears up for new projects with Maryland Department of Health

MPT and the Maryland Department of Health are collaborating on a string of new opioid addiction-related projects after working together on **Breaking Heroin's Grip: Road to Recovery** and related public service announcements (PSAs).

Five new PSAs covering topics such as how to talk with your doctor about opioids and messages about eliminating the stigma of addiction will be produced. **MPT's Education Division** will also create three educational videos, one on how to use Naloxone (an overdose prevention drug) and two on how to talk with your doctor about opioids.



MPT's Veterans initiative continues with State Circle segment

As part of MPT's ongoing commitment to honor and support the region's military veterans, **State Circle** has introduced a new segment titled *Salute to Veterans* to recognize veterans and veterans organizations making a difference in their communities. New segments air each month on Fridays at 7:30 p.m.

Initial segments this summer featured the **Frostburg State University's Student Veterans' Service** and its efforts to help veterans earn college degrees. **John J. "Jack" Farley III**, a disabled Vietnam veteran and retired U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims judge who has defied the odds to make a difference in fellow veterans' lives was also featured.



The recently aired August segment highlighted a Maryland chapter of the **Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association**, a group that participates in motorcycle-related events and donates funds to veterans care facilities and charities.

Ken Day, an executive producer at MPT, has been creating programs for our station since 1985. He has contributed to the production of some of your favorite shows, most recently *Breaking Heroin's Grip: Road to Recovery* and *MPT Salutes Vietnam Veterans*.

Planning for *MPT Salutes Vietnam Veterans* began in 2013, about three years before the 50-year anniversary of the Vietnam War. Maryland's Vietnam veterans were immensely appreciative of our efforts as a station. "To these men and women, this was a big deal," says Day.

MPT is the only place you can find these kinds of specials— locally produced and appreciated programming. "Maryland has a lot of great material to work with," says Day. "We have no shortage of material and all these smart, clever people. Storytelling is our game; we love it, and I don't think there is any staff here that just doesn't love what they do."


